Success Story - Clancy

Pets of the Homeless received a call from a homeless man in the Carson City, NV area. He is a veteran and has been living in his camper for three years. He parks his camper in the parking lot. His huge lovable black Labrador Retriever, Clancy is five years old and hadn't been feeling too good. Clancy was losing weight, straining to urinate and was extremely lethargic. We authorized an exam at a network animal hospital. They were able to quickly diagnosis Clancy with bladder stones. Clancy's case was extreme and urgent. We authorized surgery for the bladder stone removal, pre-surgery lab work, IV fluids, medications, sedation and x-rays.



Pets of the Homeless contributed \$771.61 towards Clancy's care and our vet partner offered \$185.16 in discount services and also a free nail trim and an ear exam. The man called us later to let us know that Clancy is up to his usual antics and feels so much better already.
